1. The Pakhribas Municipality has allocated funds towards the cost of road upgrading works and intends to apply part of the funds to cover eligible payments under the Contract for **Dharmashala- Mansichautara- Gambhire- Rayaghat- Bhojpur Agricultural Road Upgrading Project (Ch.0+000 to 6+580)**. Bidding is open to all eligible as per Section V of bidding document.
2. **Pakhribas Municipality** invites sealed bids or electronic bids from eligible bidders for the construction of **Rigid Pavement, Side Drain, Sub-Base Works** and cross-drainage works under National Competitive Bidding – Single Stage Two Envelope Bidding procedures.
Only eligible bidders with the following key qualifications should participate in this bidding:
 - Minimum Average Annual Construction Turnover of the best 3 years within the last 10 years: **NRs 3,92,00,000.00**
 - Minimum Work experience of similar size and nature: Participation as Prime contractor, management contractor, or subcontractor, in at least One (1) Contract within the last ten (10) years, with a value of at least **NRs 2,09,00,000.00** that have been successfully or are substantially completed and that are similar to the proposed works.
3. Under the Single Stage, Two Envelope Procedure, Bidders are required to submit simultaneously two separate sealed envelopes, one containing (i) the Technical Bid and the other (ii) the Price Bid, both in turn enclosed in one sealed envelope as per the provision of ITB 21 of the Bidding Document.

Bidders, submitting their bid electronically, should deposit the cost of bidding document in the Project's Rajaswa (revenue) account as specified below .

7. Electronic bids must be submitted to the office **Pakhribas Municipality, Office of the Municipal Executive, Pakhribas, Dhankuta** through PPMO's e-GP system www.bolpatra.gov.np/egp on or before **12:00 Hrs on 16th January 2023**. Bids received after this deadline will be rejected.
8. The bids will be opened in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend on **13:00 Hrs of 16th January 2023** at the Pakhribas Municipality, Office of the Municipal Executive, Dhankuta, Province No-1. Nepal. Bids must be valid for a period of **90 days** after bid opening and must be accompanied by a bid security or scanned copy of the bid security in pdf format in case of e-bid, amounting to a minimum of **NRs. 660,000.00** which shall be valid for 30 days beyond the validity period of the bid.
